Student Travel Award Guidelines & Instructions

The 2009 IMGC Student Travel Award is open to all graduate students working in the field of dairy science and/or genomics. The winning candidate will receive travel expenses including airfare and hotel accommodations and free registration for the 6th International Symposium on Milk Genomics & Human Health, which will be held September 28-30, 2009 at the Maison du Lait in Paris, France. The winning candidate will be responsible for making his/her own travel arrangements and will be required to make a 15-minute presentation of their paper during the Symposium session and present a poster on the selected abstract.

GUIDELINES & INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Complete the application form.
- 2) Draft a one page (300-600 words) abstract outlining the poster and paper presentation based on your research to present at the 6^h International Symposium on Milk Genomics & Human Health.
- 4) Email your application and poster abstract to the California Dairy Research Foundation at info@cdf.org or fax to (530) 753-1453.
- 5) **This material must be received by March 2, 2009.** Any applications received after March 2, 2009 will not qualify.
- 6) Consultation with your Faculty or Professional Advisor regarding a poster topic is encouraged.
- 7) **IMPORTANT:**
 - a) All material must be typed.
 - b) Your poster abstract cannot exceed one page or it will be disqualified. Winning candidates will be required to provide a poster display for the symposium. Posters must adhere to the display guidelines outlined at www.milkgenomics.org.
- 9) Reimbursed travel expenses will be based on advance-purchased coach air travel and three room nights at the program hotel. Some limitations apply.
- 10) Selection of the winning candidate(s) will be made by the IMGC Scientific Advisory Committee. Winning candidate(s) will be notified in April 2009.
