for 4th International Symposium on Milk Genomics & Human Health**

The International Milk Genomics Consortium (IMGC) recently announced the establishment of a student travel scholarship for the 4th International Symposium on Milk Genomics and Human Health, which will be held November 7-9, 2007 in Napa, California. The award, open to graduate students throughout the world involved in the field of dairy and genomics will provide up to \$1,000 for travel expenses and free registration (a \$300 value) for the symposium.

Application forms and scholarship requirements are available online at www.milkgenomics.org. **The deadline to apply is August 27, 2007.** Winning applicants will be required to submit a poster for display during the symposium event. 2007 IMGC Travel Scholarship Guidelines & Instructions

The 2007 IMGC Travel Scholarship is open to all graduate students working in the field of dairy science and/or genomics. The winning candidate will receive a travel stipend of up to \$1,000 (see guidelines below) and free registration for the 4th International Symposium on Milk Genomics & Human Health, which will be held November 7-9, 2007 at the COPIA Center for Wine, Food & the Arts in Napa, California. The winning candidate will be responsible for making his/her own travel arrangements.

GUIDELINES & INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Complete the enclosed application form.
- 2) Draft a one page (300-500 words) abstract outlining the poster presentation based on your research that you would present at the 4th International Symposium on Milk Genomics & Human Health.
- 4) Email or fax your application and poster abstract to the California Dairy Research Foundation at info@cdf.org or fax to (530) 753-1453.
- 5) **This material must be received by August 27, 2007.** Any applications received after August 27, 2007 will not qualify.
- 6) Consultation with your Faculty or Professional Advisor regarding a poster topic is encouraged.
- 7) **IMPORTANT:**
 - a) All material must be typed.
 - b) Your poster abstract cannot exceed one page or it will be disqualified. Winning candidates will be required to provide a poster display for the symposium. Posters must adhere to the display guidelines outlined at www.milkgenomics.org.
- 9) Travel stipends will be awarded on a sliding scale based on a student's geographic location: \$500 for US applicants and up to \$1,000 for international applicants.
- 10) Selection of the winning candidate(s) will be made by the IMGC Scientific Advisory Committee. Winning candidate(s) will be notified by September 5, 2007.
